



2016 Youth Summer Camps

Contact the Madison County Conservation Board to sign up for camps at 462-3536. Minimum of 3 children required for each camp and a maximum of 20.

***Let's Move (Ages 3-5):** This camp is for pre-school age children and will meet once a month over the summer to encourage kids to get up, get out and get moving. We will build mazes, run through obstacle courses, practice some basic yoga poses and take hikes through Pammel Park. Parents and guardians are welcome and encouraged to stay and participate for the hour and a half sessions.

Camp dates: June 3, July 1 AND August 3 (10:30 AM to Noon)

***Rock Hounds (Ages 5-7):** Fossil hunting is addicting and prolific in Madison County Parks. We are offering two different sessions. Choose the one that's right for you and plan on learning about geology, marine environments and get ready to hike and explore new fossil hunting spots .

Camp dates: June 7-9 (9-11 AM) OR August 9-11 (1-3 PM)

***Animal Planet (Ages 7-9):** This camp will explore the unique wildlife in and around Madison County and throughout the world. We will learn about different habitats and adaptations that different animals have and will be visited by guest animals from the Blank Park Zoo!

Camp dates: June 20-22 (1-3 PM) OR July 27-29 (1-3 PM)

***Plant. Grow. Fly. (Ages 8-12):** As part of a 'save the pollinators' initiative, Madison County Conservation Board has partnered with the Blank Park Zoo's Plant.Grow.Fly. Program to raise awareness and help create habitat for native pollinators and resting spots for great migrations. We will learn about butterflies and bees and why pollinators are important and will plant more gardens!

Camp dates: June 14-16 (9-11:30 AM)

***Going Green (Ages 9-11):** This NEW camp will focus on the 3 R's (reduce, reuse, recycle), simple things we can do to help the planet and how to reduce our own carbon footprint and be a green leader in our community. Live simply; leave only footprints, take only memories.

Camp dates: July 12-14 (12:30 to 3 PM)

***Water Rocks! (Ages 9-12):** This is a NEW camp based off the Water Rocks! curriculum provided by ISU Extension services and the Iowa Learning Farms and will focus on all things WATER by integrating science with music, the arts and technology. There is a chance we will be getting wet!

Camp dates: July 18-20 (9-12 AM)

***Family Camp (All ages):** This camp is an opportunity for families to play and camp together in Pammel Park. Minimum of one adult is required to participate. Afternoon activities will focus around fishing, hiking and games. Dinner will be around the campfire followed by s'mores and evening entertainment TBA. We will sleep in tents (bring your own or borrow one of ours) near the Nature Center.
